

SCHEDULE OF DAILY ACTIVITIES
FOR FULL AND EXTENDED DAY PROGRAMS FOR TODDLERS

TIME	ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION
07:00 AM 08:00 AM	Classroom	Arrival, Greeting and Free Choice (puzzles, easel, table activity, books, etc.)
08:00 AM 08.55 AM	Breakfast	Children are offered breakfast or they can do a quiet activity.
08:30 AM 09:00 AM	Personal Hygiene	Children wash hands, toilet training attempt for those getting trained.
09:00 AM 09:30 AM	Music and Movement	Children gain practice in large motor skills through movement activities to a variety of music.
09:30 AM 10:00 AM	Small Group Activity	Children participate in a teacher directed writing, language or numerical project geared towards problem solving or deductive Reasoning.
10:00 AM 10:45 AM	Snack/Outdoor Activities	Children focus on large muscle and social skills. The concept of "taking turns" is practiced.
10:45 AM 11:40 AM	Circle Time & Project Time	Children sing songs, participate in a learning activity, group games, and practice counting & language skills. Children engage in various art activities, cooking activities, literacy, activities, blocks, dramatic play, etc.
11:40 AM 11:45 AM	Wash Hands	Children are helped to wash their hands before and after each meal.
11:45 AM 12:20 PM	Lunch	Children practice good table manners, naming food as they eat their lunch. Teachers help children wash their face and hands after lunch.
12:25 PM 02:15 PM	Nap	Children listen to music as they fall asleep. Children not needing rest are offered quiet activities to do during this time.
02:15 PM 03:30 PM	Snack/Free Choice & Outdoor Activities	Children are awakened. After their bedding is put away, they go outside, and have snacks. If the weather does not allow, children engage in indoor play. Children focus on large muscle and social skills. Group games are offered during this time.
03:30 PM 04:30 PM	Teacher Selected Activities	Teacher read out books to the Children. Music and Movement, Circle time, picture book character recognition time.
04:30 PM 06:00 PM	Child Selected Activities/ Departure	Children select their own areas of play, blocks, discovery, puzzles, picture books etc. Ready to go home.
